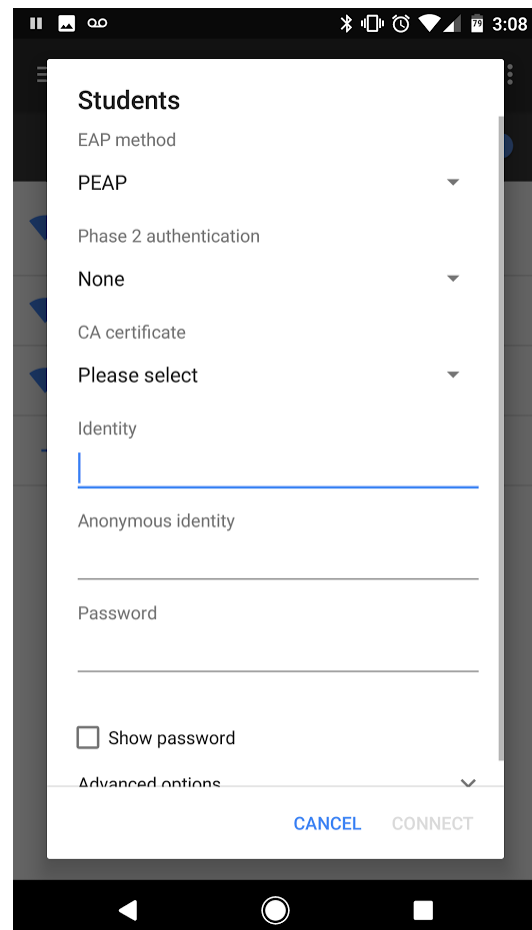
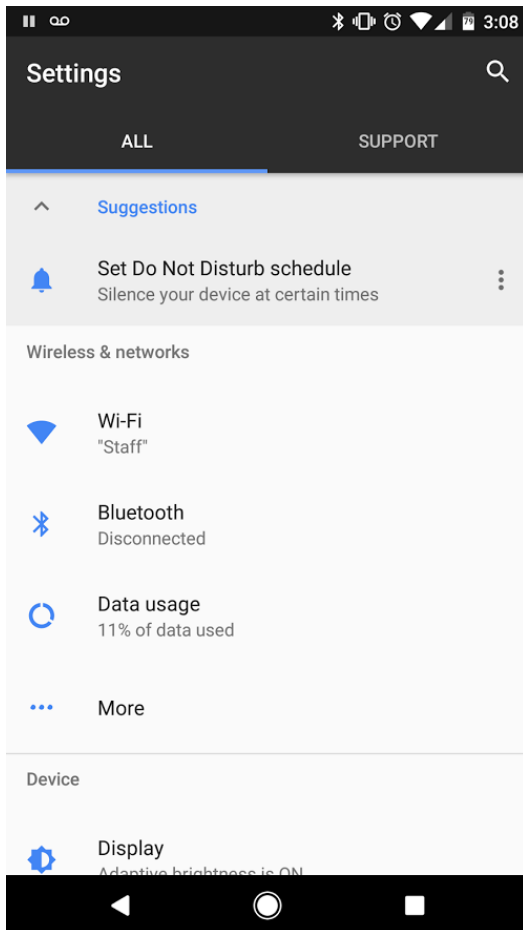


How to connect to “Students” WiFi on your Android phone (Android Version 7.1.1 & Later)

1. Open the Wi-Fi settings on your device and tap on the “Students” network to bring up the configuration window. Please configure using the settings on the following page.

Depending on your device these screens may look different.

This setup was done on a Google Pixel



NOTE: Not all android devices will require all of these settings. Some devices only require Identify and your Password to allow connection.

2. Please set the following settings for your device:

EAP method: PEAP

**Phase 2 Authentication
MSCHAPV2**

**CA Certificate
Use system certificates**

**Domain
peap.flemingc.on.ca**

**Identify
Your Fleming username (ex: jsmith)**

**Anonymous Identity
Leave this blank**

**Password
Your Fleming password**

You may now tap connect in the bottom right.

3. Once you tap connect your device should say "Obtaining IP Address" once complete it should change to "Connected" and you should be online
